

The TO 7 thematic network for transport is aiming at supporting Interreg programmes when it comes to increasing the knowledge about sustainable transport policies and practices. The network shall also be a natural place to share success stories as well as discuss challenges that Interreg programs face when implementing projects in the field of TO7.

Furthermore the idea is to collect ideas and means to increase the added value of Interreg achievements in the field of Sustainable transport. The network has met 4 times online to share the state of play in individual programmes and to discuss some common features. The first meeting in person was organised in Prague, Czech Republic at the end of January 2017.

During that meeting it was agreed that all programmes in the network will share successes and challenges and that all programmes also will make their efforts visible in KEEP.EU In order to make that part easier a training on how to use KEEP.EU was arranged in the Prague meeting.

Objectives

The objective for the second meeting is to learn more about EU policies regarding transport both on an EU level but also on a macro-regional level. Therefore part of the meeting will be a joint meeting with the transport coordinators from the four EU macro-regions. We have also invited colleagues both from DG Move and DG Regio to set the scene in a broader context.

But we are also showing and sharing good examples of what have already been achieved and how Interreg can have a global view even though working in a regional area.

Last but not least the important discussion on how we together can enhance the visibility of Interreg to the outside world will continue and we will brainstorm on how to do this together.
