Interreg V Programme VIKINGIA (FI-SE-DK-DE-NL- PL)

The objective: to strengthen the integrated territorial development and cooperation for a more innovative VIKINGIA Region

Budget: 310 Million € (ERDF)

Co-financing rates:

50% for (FI, SE, DK) 75% for (DE, NL, PL)

Flexibility rules:

max 10% per budget line max 10% reallocation between the partners two modifications are allowed during the project lifetime.

Eligible institutions:

local, regional and national public authorities; research and training institutions; sectoral agencies and associations; NGOs; enterprises;





'Cooperation to Facilitate Entrepreneurship in Remote Areas' (co-FERA)

Project main objective:

To improve services of business incubators in peripheral areas in order to provide better targeted support and finance to individuals who are planning to start or expand their small and medium enterprise.

Main outputs:

- Network of business incubators in remote areas.
- Training package offered by business incubators in peripheral areas to support SME development, export and internationalisation.
- Online platform for newly established SMEs to facilitate their internationalisation and export activities.
