Cross-programme work environment – National Authority

- ➤one office working both with INTERREG and ENI programmes (7 persons)
- ➤ cooperation with mainstream programmes (ESI funds) via **National sub-committee** for ensuring synergy and additionality
- <u>internal division of staff − capitalisation of processes</u>
 - > by territorial approach for overlapping territories
 - by policy making approach in relevant region
 - > by thematic specialization across programmes
 - by inter-programme capacity building approach



Coordination/communication on national/international level

- **►INTERREG** page on Ministry's web page (one-shop approach for applicants)
- >facebook account on INTERREG programmes in Latvia
- >contribution to national/interanational thematic events
- ➤ participation in different policy-making discussion formats and coordination of strategic issues for INTERREG (CBC obstacles, MRS, Cohesion Policy post 2020)

Thematic capitalisation on national level

☐ Thematic seminars – INTERREG make a difference		
		At least twice a year
		Gathering together projects and final beneficiaries from different INTERREG programmes dealing with the same theme (clustering)
		Highlighting planned results and benefits for Latvian partners in simple language (telling stories), but also individuals!
		Involving moderator/ policy-makers/ stakeholders outside INTERREG community
		Providing format for panel discussion among projects/outside projects
		Boosting potential ideas for future projects / finding partners



Thematic capitalisation - challenges

- ➤ Gaps between calls for proposals/ project activities
- **≻Variety of themes** in INTERREG projects
- **▶ Different understanding** of TOs/SOs
- > Different expectations from stakeholders
- **▶** Lack of understanding on **INTERREG specificity**
- ▶Lack of permanent cooperation with mainstream programmes
- **▶** Lack of **monitoring tools for follow-ups**
- >SOLUTIONS?



Expected results of capitalisation activities

- √ Visibility/understandingof INTERREG results on national level
- ✓ Identifying good practices to be multiplied and re-used
- ✓ Valuable exchange/feedback from different stakeholders on spot
- ✓ Development of a pool of contact + networking for projects
- √ Contribution to staff capacity building
- ✓ Contribution to targeted communication on INTERREG
- ✓ Contribution to policy-making discussion on strategic level (line ministries, responsible bodies)
- ✓Intra-programme synergies within /beyond INTERREG

BUT MAY BE ALSO

- ✓Increased impact on territory (beyond one Programme)
- ✓ Emerging ideas for new partnership/follow-up activities
- ✓ Support for promotion of INTERREG for post 2020?



Capitalisation – next steps?

- More specific events, more success stories on INTERREG:
 - > Transport
 - > Better governance/public services
- Separate web page for INTERREG in Latvia
- ▶Cross-sectoral capitalisation event (inclusive urban governance) Summer School for municipalities 2018
- **≻Capitalisation in new formats?**
- ➤ Trainings led by external thematic experts?





Capitalisation for strategic purposes

- Assessment of impact/ analytical work for discussion on INTERREG post 2020
 - Thematic scope (demand vs offer)
 - Geographical scope
 - Needs for simplification
 - Value of money
 - New trends in cooperation
 - > Synergy and additionality to mainstream programmes
 - Replication potential /transferability of results
 - Impact and added value of INTERREG on policy level
- >Lobbying exercise via National sub-committee
- **▶Positionning of INTERREG** (meta-story/critical mass) in overal discussion on Cohesion Policy post 2020
