Title: Ancient roman cultural heritage interactive visualization environment for the cross border area between Bulgaria and Romania

Brief description: The project aims to bringing back to life important cultural heritage, namely 16 Roman sites from the entire Romania-Bulgaria cross-border area. High quality images, videos, 3D models and printed artefacts were created, as well as the web platform www.romanforts.eu and mobile apps, where you can visit them virtually.

Results: Attraction of 4 500 new visitors to the Roman sites; creation of 2 integrated tourism products were developed, and presented at international tourism events; establishment of a model for the sustainable use of the cultural heritage of the cross-border area emerged, thus improving the tourism in the area.

Title: Underwater Museums for responsible tourism and Blue growth in the Mediterranean



Brief description: The project aims to promote innovation in the diving industry and improve divers' experience through innovative diving services and technologies. Furthermore, the project intends to attract more diving tourism and to introduce the wider public to underwater cultural heritage by means of 3D immersive visualization in museum exhibitions and Knowledge Awareness Centres (KACs).

Results: Valorisation and protection of underwater natural and cultural heritage in accordance with UNESCO 2001 convention, the raising of public awareness and tourism attractiveness, through planning, testing and coordinating Underwater Museums, Diving Parks and KACs.

Title: Acting for the transition to a low carbon economy in schools - development of support tools

Brief description: Climate change is real and affects all of us. Schools can empower students to become sustainable development actors by demonstrating and promoting innovative low carbon solutions. ClimACT aims to reduce the schools' carbon footprint by incorporating complementary approaches such as energy efficiency, resources conservation and behavioural change.

Results: ClimACT developed a holistic approach to support the transition to a low carbon economy in schools. It also created decision support tools, developed new business models and empowered students with knowledge about climate change and sustainable development.

Title: Low Carbon Transport in Cruise
Destination Cities



Brief description: Locations promotes sustainable growth and low-carbon strategies in MED cruise destinations by acting on the capacity of ports and local authorities to jointly develop planning tools for sustainable mobility of people and goods related to cruise flows, improving accessibility and quality of life for tourists and local populations alike.

Results: LOCATIONS developed 18 low-carbon transport plans as well as 14 modular packages, which will provide local and port authorities of MED territories with concrete solutions to reduce cruise-related impacts on natural and cultural assets.

Title: Danube Region information platform
for economic Integration of Migrants

Brief description: Successful integration of migrants starts with an easily accessible adequate information. Eight countries of Danube region joined forces in DRIM to provide migrants with a practical online tool "Danube Compass" where all the information can be found at one place. DRIM also raises awareness among public institutions and decision makers to allow the needed systemic changes on this issue.

Results: Imagine coming to a new country and wanting to know where to find a job or how to get your driving licence. You go to the local municipal office and a friendly clerk explains to you that he is very happy to support you with the information, while more is available online at this integrated and easy-to-use tool: danubecompass.org.

Results: RaiSE allows a continuous exchange of experiences to help social enterprises to climb the "mountain of competitiveness" and to serve as inspiration of any policy maker in the European Union dealing with social enterprises competitiveness. Specifically, the project provides specialised training, research and exchange services.
