


Hierarchy of provisions 2014-2020

Used simplified cost options

- Costs are not expected to match the paid sums



FLC role

- FLC as an independent controller is the basis of the programme's control system
 - Irregularities not identified = programme error rate
- FLC must make cuts if issues are detected
- Projects expect a high-quality FLC service



Who uses FLC work

- Project partners
- Lead partner
- JS staff in assesing the project reports
- MA staff in makeing payments, annual analysis and reporting to Commission
- Second level auditors
