




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

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Regulatory framework and guidance

2014 - 2020







Preamble of Regulation (EU) No 1299/2013 - ETC Regulation

- (26) (...) the **managing authority** should ensure that evaluations of cooperation programmes are carried out on the basis of the evaluation plan and include evaluations to assess the effectiveness, efficiency and impact of those programmes (...).
- (33) The **managing authority** should set up a **joint secretariat** which should, inter alia, provide information to applicants for support, deal with project applications and assist beneficiaries in implementing their operations.
- (34) **Managing authorities** should be responsible for the functions laid down in Regulation (EU) No 1303 /2013, including for **management verifications**, in order to ensure <u>uniform standards across the whole programme area</u>. (...)

CHAPTER III - Programming

Article 8 (13). The **managing authority** shall notify the Commission of any decision amending the elements of the cooperation programme not covered by the Commission decision referred to in paragraph 12, within one month of the date of that amending decision.

Article 12 (5). For each operation, the **managing authority** shall provide to the lead or sole beneficiary a document setting out the conditions for support of the operation, including the specific requirements concerning the products or services to be delivered under the operation, the financing plan, and the time – limit for execution.

CHAPTER IV - Monitoring and evaluation

Article 14 (1). (...) the **managing authority** shall submit to the Commission an annual implementation report in accordance with Article 50(1) of Regulation (EU) No 1303/2013.

CHAPTER VI – Management, control and designation

<u>Article 23</u>. (1) Without prejudice to paragraph 4 of this Article, the <u>managing authority</u> of a cooperation programme shall carry out the functions laid down in <u>Article 125</u> of Regulation (EU) No 1303/2013.

- (2) The managing authority, after **consultation** with the Member States and any third countries participating in a cooperation programme, shall set up a joint secretariat.
- (4) Where the managing authority does not carry out verifications under point (a) of Article 125(4) of CPR throughout the whole programme area, or where the verifications are not carried out by or under the responsibility of the managing authority (...) **each Member State** or, where it has accepted the invitation to participate in the cooperation programme, **each third country** or territory shall designate the body or person responsible for carrying out such verifications in relation to beneficiaries on its territory **(the 'controller(s)').**

CHAPTER VI – Management, control and designation

<u>Article 23</u>. (1) Without prejudice to paragraph 4 of this Article, the <u>managing authority</u> of a cooperation programme shall carry out the functions laid down in <u>Article 125</u> of Regulation (EU) No 1303/2013:

- manages the OP in compliance with the sound financial management principle;
- supports the work of the Monitoring Committee;
- submits to the EC annual and final implementation reports;
- establishes a system to record and store data on each operation in computerised form;

CHAPTER VI – Management, control and designation

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Joint secretariat: what



The **joint secretariat** shall <u>assist</u> the managing authority and the monitoring committee in carrying out their respective functions. The **joint secretariat** shall also provide information to potential beneficiaries about funding opportunities under cooperation programmes and shall assist beneficiaries in the implementation of operations.

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National controllers: what


Verifications pursuant to Art. 125 shall include the following procedures:

- (a) administrative verifications in respect of each application for reimbursement by beneficiaries;
- (b) on-the-spot verifications of operations.













Management Verifications





How many levels of control exist in Interreg?

- 1) Project partner (internal control)
- Lead partner (partner activities related to the project, have been verified by national controls, EU co-financing has been forwarded to partner)
- 3) National controls
- 4) JS/MA checks
- 5) Audit Authority
- 6) European Commission Auditors
- 7) European Court of Auditors





Management verifications – regulatory framework

- Regulation (EU) No. 1303/2013 (Common Provisions CPR):
 - Art. 125.4 (scope of verifications)
 - Art. 125.5 (administrative and on-the-spot)
 - Art. 125.6 (on-the-spot sampling)
- Regulation (EU) No. 1299/2013 (ETC):
 - Art. 23 (ETC-specific rules)
- Delegated Act No. 481/2014 on eligibility of expenditure



In ETC, MS can designate a body responsible for verification Ensure that expenditure has been verified by controller




MS ensures verification within 3 months










National control: Typical Scope






Lead Partner: Typical Scope (Art 13.2.c ETC)






MA/JS: Typical Scope - Monitoring
