

Outlines

Interreg programmes also invest in social policy topics such as unemployment and self-employment, labour mobility, social inclusion and fighting against poverty (including health investment). Professional skills and lifelong learning have been addressed for many years. In the current programming period 2014-2020, 1.4 billion euros are being allocated by Interreg to Inclusive Growth challenges.

In this context, Interact launched the **Inclusive Growth thematic network** in order to build capacity among the EU cooperation programmes. Its primary goal is to make available relevant data to better understand the topic in the EU context and to share practices among the social policy stakeholders. Through the network we will intend to articulate and support a common Interreg response to the EU Inclusive Growth policy.

It is difficult to avoid the EU current challenges. On the one hand, the fact that the new financial perspectives are being negotiated with a lower budget. On the other, the implementation since November 2017 of the EU Social Pillar, giving a higher relevance to a Social Europe. Under this framework, the network will be used as a space of information and exchange on the latest financial and legislative updates for Inclusive Growth after 2020.

Objectives

When talking about "Inclusive Growth", people automatically think of specific funds devoted to this area, such as the European Social Fund (ESF). But not many of them know that Interreg, ENI and IPA programmes also promote inclusive growth with projects that work hard to increase the quality of the labour market and employment, foster vocational training, or fight against discrimination and poverty. In this context, the event will have 3 main objectives:

- 1. To demonstrate the added value of Cooperation programmes (Interreg, ENI and IPA) in the European Social Policy. Interact will present the Desk Research launched in May 2018, followed by a debate with the EC Commission and practitioners.
- 2. To learn more about the programmes financing EU Social Policy and discuss on how overlaps can turn into complementarities.
 - Different EU Cooperation programmes, together with the ERDF and ESF funds will share their experiences on how there are tackling Inclusive Growth and improving EU social policy in the current period
 - On day 2, a field visit is organised by Vorarlberg Region, Alpine Space and Interact. We will visit several projects financed by different funds but all related to Inclusive Growth such as migrants' integration, ageing and children social inclusion.
- 3. To know more about the social dimension on the post 2020 discussions for Interreg and ESF+.

The meeting will be interactive between speakers and audience. For this, questions and answers will be encouraged during all sessions.
