Outline

The programming process of post-2020 programmes has already started to some extent, so it is time to start preparing the Harmonised Implementation Tools (HIT) for the next implementation period. Many colleagues from Interreg programmes have already contacted Interact to ask for a meeting where we could reflect on the use of HIT 2014-2020, and discuss what the future holds. To kick off the development process, Interact is organizing the first meeting in preparation for the next generation of HIT.

HIT is a collective term for a set of templates and guidance documents developed for a wide range of programme management tasks. HIT was first developed for the 2014-2020 implementation period, through a broad participatory process involving a large number of Interreg programmes. You can download the HIT 2014-2020 package <u>here</u>.

The aim of this meeting is twofold:

- Reflect on the lessons learnt from the use of HIT in the 2014-2020 programming period.
- Kick-off the preparation of a new HIT for the 2021-2027 programming period.

Who should join us in Berlin

During the meeting we will be discussing issues such as how programmes will work together in preparation of the HIT 2021-2027 package, and what are programmes' experiences with the currently used HIT 2014-2020. This is why the event is mainly for Heads of Secretariats and/or colleagues from Secretariats with practical knowledge of how HIT has been used in the implementation of the programme they are representing.

But, regardless of your experience with HIT you should attend if you are interested in working on it in the next period.

Directions to the venue

From the central train station (Hauptbahnhof)

By Taxi: about 18 minutes By S-Bahn: about 15 minutes

At Hauptbahnhof/central train station, take the S-Bahn S75, S9, S7 or S5 towards Spandau, Potsdam or Westkreuz. After 3 stops change at station "Zoologischer Garten" to U9 U-Bahn (metro) towards Rathaus Steglitz. Exit at Spichernstraße and walk down the street until Nürnberger Straße. SANA Berlin Hotel is on the left-hand side.

From the airport - Berlin Tegel

By Taxi: about 20-30 minutes By Bus/metro: about 25 minutes

At the airport, take the TXL bus heading towards Alexanderplatz until you reach Turmstraße station. At Turmstraße, take the U9 metro heading towards Rathaus Steglitz. Exit at Spichernstraße and walk down the street until Nürnberger Straße. SANA Berlin Hotel is on the left-hand side.

From the airport - Berlin Schönefeld

By Taxi: about 35 - 60 minutes By Bus/metro: about 50 minutes

At the airport, take the X7 bus heading towards Rudow. At U-Rudow station, take the U7 metro line heading towards S+U Rathaus Spandau. At Berliner Straße station change to U9 metro line heading towards Osloer Straße station. Exit at Spichernstraße and walk down the street until Nürnberger Straße SANA Berlin Hotel is on the left-hand side.
