1. Required basic information

Structure of the database:

- project number (=> priority)(e.g. 5.11.1 Technical Assistance)
- project name
- lead partner
- bank account certificate
- signed subsidy contract
- total budget (TEC and ERDF)

- public/private financing
- changes budget/subsidy contract need to be clear (e.g. summary with date and version number)
- all financial / subsidy contract changes
 should be automatically notified to the CA

- total budget (TEC and ERDF)
- public/private financing



Notification to CA with changes in the subsidy contract or budget (e.g. bank account, name of partner, amount TEC, ...)

2. Payment order (printable)

- priority
- project number
- project name
- lead partner
- bank account lead partner
- total amount TEC and ERDF payment order
- total amount TEC and ERDF per partner
- (total MS Contribution for TA)
- total amount public / private per partner
- date and number of the payment order

Notification to CA if MA validates payment order

Functionalities for CA in the monitoring system

Ultimate payment date for CA:

23

- Payment term for CA
- 90 days between declaration of partner and payment by CA
- Timeline of all controls on the payment request
- Possibility to validate or refuse payment order (with comment)
- When date of payment is entered <u>by CA</u>, mail to LP is processed with details for payment to partners

- Possibility to correct manually entered data (e.g. date of payment)
- CA checklist for payments, IPC/FPC, accounts as part of the payment procedure
- All relevant documents uploaded in the system (quality control CA)

3. Interim / Final Payment Claim

- list of all payments to projects in a certain period
- possibility to select payments to certify to EC (e.g. amount on going quality controls are left out, draft version of IPC/FPC)
- possibility to leave out negative lines (corrections to be deducted in accounts)
- overview in relation to each accounting year
- date of submission of IPC is automatically added to expenditure
- number IPC: ay_IPC 1 ay_IPC 2 ay_IPC 3 etc. or IPC 1 to 10

4. Accounts

- <u>Irregularities</u>:
- Withdrawal or recovery
- Amount TEC and ERDF
- Corresponding public contribution
- Date of validation by MA
- Accounting year in which the expenditure is declared to EC
- Number and/or date of IPC
- Nature of finding (e.g. art. 71)
- Follow-up: recovered (by repayment?), to be recovered, irrecoverable

- Errors < 250 EUR to recover or not
- List of all negative lines on expenditure in relation to each accounting year
- Possibility to select corrections to deduct in appendix 1 of the accounts
 - (e.g. corrections in IPC => appendix 2, 3 or 5 of Annex VII, draft version accounts)
- Date of submission in accounts is automatically added to expenditure
