











Use of HIT - 73 programmes in 2015

Reasons for not adopting HIT tools

Reasons	Answers in %
Good experience with programme-specific tools from last period.	31
We have to use a specific monitoring (national) system which couldn't be adapted to the HIT.	28
More flexibility needed to adapt tools to programme needs.	25
Tools are too complex for our programme.	9
Other reason.	6
Use of tools is not supported by our Monitoring Committee.	0

Most common type of modifications


Type of modification	Application Form	Project Progress Report	FLC Control Report
None or only minor modifications (e.g. changes in wording)	31 %	58 %	71 %
Substantial changes to compulsory questions or tables	15 %	11 %	0 %
Omission of (compulsory) questions or tables	23 %	11 %	7 %
Additional questions or tables (other than the optional ones)	31 %	21 %	21 %
