- Participation possible only under the Observer Partner status no EU funds.
- Travel & Accommodation costs allocated to a core Partner from the Partnership.

### **Current State of Programme's Implementation (2)**

- 37 projects contracted by the end of 2017; overall contracted budget of Projects in PA1 and P2 of approximately 36 MEUR;
- 7 projects reserve list to be contracted by the end of 2019; overall budget of Reserve List Projects in PA1 & PA2 of approximately 6.177.053,71 €;
- JS recruitment completed fully staffed and active since July 2017; comprised of five members plus one;
- 5 Info Days on Project Implementation in 5 BalkanMed countries (September-October 2017);
- Value of the control of the contr
- Adaptation of the Management Information System (MIS) of the Programme to the regulatory requirements of the 2014-2020 Programming Period and the Programme/ Project management needs;
- Risk Management and Anti-fraud strategies developed to reply to demanding regulatory requirements;
- Programme Information and Publicity supported EC Days, Capitalization event, Website, Social Media






## **Financial Performance**



## Rate of project selection and expenditure







# **Key Features in Implementation**



- No pre-financing payment to ERDF & IPA Project Partners
- No flexibility rule on MIS verification of Expenditures
- No 2<sup>nd</sup> Call for Project Proposals

## **BM** challenges

- Working (remotely) in large partnerships
- Meeting European reporting, control and audit requirements – complicated processes, bureaucracy, slow implementation -- ERDF-IPA funds, limited IPA funds
- Need for partner liquidity no advance payment
- Project modifications
- Partnership modifications i.e. problematic partner liquidity; staff costs limits; public procurement

Need for more simplification and flexibility

- "Innoplatform" participated in the Q&A event delivering a presentation on business innovation.












