### DRIM – Danube Region Information Platform for Economic Integration of Migrants

#### AIM:

To improve access to infromation for migrants in the Danube region.

#### HOW:

By creating new information source for migrants and people who work with migrants, carrying out trainings with front desk employees, workshops with decisionmakers, giving recommendations how to improve the information infrastructure.

TARGET GROUP: Public institutions, migrants.

PROGRAM: Danube transnational program (Danube Interreg)

## **MUTUAL LEARNING ON INFORMATION SHARING**

Working closely with public institutions and NGO sector

Pilot actions: 294 PI employees & migrants included

Trainings for public institutions – 204 employees included

Worksops with decisionmakers: almost 100 decisionmakers from the region included

Round 6000 migrants & refugees directly targeted

Information on work procedures, administrative aspects, education, health and every day life


Great level of detail, careful wording, verified information




