#### **Outline**

According to the agreed "roadmap" of the HIT development the group will work on the proposed HIT tools for project selection (Application Form, Budget tables, Quality Assessment sheet and Administrative/Eligibility check). #### From the airport (Amsterdam Schiphol)


By train: From Schiphol Airport, take the Sprinter Light train towards Amsterdam RAI, Almere Oostvaarders or Hilversum. You will arrive at the RAI train station in 10-14 minutes. From the RAI train station, take the bus nr. 62 toward Station Lelylaan and get off at the Kastelenstraat stop. Bus 62 will stop in front of the hotel.

Taxi: It is around 15 minutes trip and costs around 40€.

Airport shuttle: Departs every 30 minutes and costs 17€

#### From the Amsterdam RAI train station

From the RAI train station take bus 62 toward Station Lelylaan. Get off at the Kastelenstraat stop. Bus 62 will stop in front of the hotel.
