

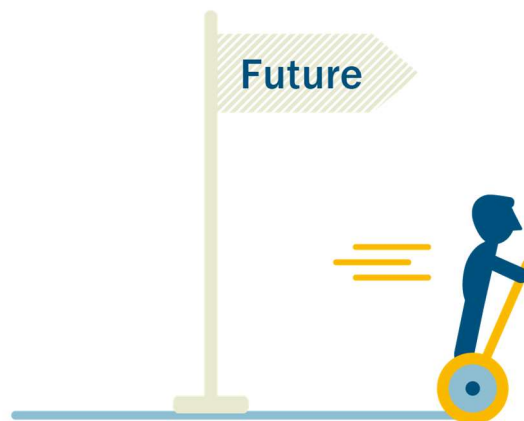

Outline

Post 2020, the implementation of external programmes will be subject to the provisions of the Interreg Regulation. Specificities of external programmes might lead to implications, which are different from those for internal Interreg programmes.

The draft post-2020 regulatory framework was published in May 2018 and both co-legislators have reviewed it. The start of trilogue is pending.

In a dedicated group of Member State's and programme representatives, we would like to:

- Hear Commission's and practitioner's views;
- Discuss and exchange.
