


### Yearly expenditure in medical research (2009)<sup>1</sup>

#### Why?1

Questions relevant to clinicians and patients?

Low priority questions addressed

Important outcomes not assessed

Clinicians and patients not involved in setting research agendas

Appropriate design and methods?

Over 50% of studies designed without reference to systematic reviews of existing evidence

Over 50% of studies fail to take adequate steps to reduce biases – e.g. unconcealed treatment allocation

Accessible full publication?


Over 50% of studies never published in full

Biased underreporting of studies with disappointing results Unbiased and usable report?

Over 30% of trial interventions not sufficiently described

Over 50% of planned study outcomes not reported

Most new research not interpreted in the context of systematic assessment of other relevant evidence

### KAMUT (keep.eu automatic and manual updating tool)

- Application used for editing and importing data to keep.eu, including partner geocoding
- Built-in modules:
  - Language detection and thematic assignment tool (including translation to EN)
  - Work online as excel format
  - Partner vs partnership management
  - Automatic and manual data validation / cleaning
  - SO-TO-IP-TP reference tool
  - Project output configuration
  - Validated partner email address list
  - Revisions



### KAMUT (keep.eu automatic and manual updating tool)

- Validators and automatic data cleaning:
  - Date formatting
  - HTML tags replaced with the actual formatting
  - Country names
  - Programme names mapping
  - Language separation
  - Programme specific objectives
  - Format of the different fields
  - Mandatory fields




#### KAMUT roles

- KAMUT data operator: Data operator role allows importing of data files and performing all operations to the imported data.
- **KAMUT Admin**: Data supervisor role allows all operations including thematic assignment changes and data publication.
- **KAMUT Programme user**: Any programme user that has been granted access. Can edit imported files once submission is done by KAMUT data operator. Can also edit, and publish, at any time published data.

## How to edit imported data using new KAMUT

- Reject a file: reject the file completely
- View entries: View and edit projects, partnerships and calls
- Export: export data in the file in keep.eu format
  - Download current: Download the file in KAMUT format with all changes
  - Download original: Download the original file
- Autopublish date: Date after the data will be automatically published if no extension asked




