Outline

EU macro-regional strategies (MRS/Strategy) address societal and ecological challenges shared within a wider territory. The Strategies work towards coordinated development and implementation of EU policies, they address challenges across borders, integrating various policy sectors and taking multilevel governance as their guiding principle. The MRS helps to incorporate different perspectives to find a more effective way of addressing common matters. Neighbouring countries are involved in the MRS, therefore the Strategies are not just tools for supporting integration within the European Union but also across the whole of Europe.

Four existing MRS are at different implementation stages, though there are similarities between them. The MRS are very much alike in terms of thematic, governance structures and implementation processes. Each Strategy aims to achieve set objectives, defined targets and indicators.

We, the Interact Programme, support the development of new ways of cooperation involving the macro-regional framework. Moreover, the Council Conclusions on the implementation of the MRS¹ request that Interact supports exchanges across the MRS.

Meeting across the MRS coordinators dealing with biodiversity and ecological connectivity thematic is initiated by the coordinators of the EUSDR priority area 6 'To preserve biodiversity, landscapes and the quality of air and soils'. The initiative is elaborated within the DTP-PAC-1PA6 project of the Interreg Danube Transnational Programme. The Project activity 'Fostering synergies across MRS', aims to explore potential for more systematic sectoral exchange and cooperation of thematic areas of the existing MRS.

The EUSALP Action group 7 'To develop ecological connectivity in the whole EUSALP territory' has been also expressing their interest in cross-MRS exchange.

Objectives

The meeting aims at fostering an exchange of experience and explore further collaboration potential across the MRS in the field of ecological connectivity. Moreover, the participants will look into initiatives that have the potential to be transferred to other macro-regions.

Primarily target group for the event is thematic coordinators from all MRS, project implementers and Interreg programmes dealing with the topic.
