

# Interact Med Lab Group Briefing on the Southern Europe and Mediterranean area. December 2019.

# What happened in Southern Europe and the Mediterranean in 2019?

Recap on the activities and events and tools developed in this area.

- I. 2019 has been a year with a particular focus **post 2020**, in this context a <u>Map of EU cooperation</u> <u>Territorial Coverage</u>. This map shows the 2013-2020 Interreg,, ENI and IPA programmes territorial status quo.
- II. Coastal Tourism is one of the main topics of the EU cooperation programmes in the Med area. In order to highlight the projects achievements and capitalise results among the programmes operating in the Mediterranean, Interact organised a workshop on Innovative Practices in Coastal Tourism. - III. **Fishing Tourism** as an example of Sustainable Coast tourism. *Tourismed* an Interreg Med project open their doors to us. See more in this <u>video</u>.
- IV. Interact's Med Lab Group participates in two Mediterranean governance process as observer and associated partner respectively.
  - WestMed Initiative, which has organised national hubs in the 5+5 countries involved to promote Mediterranean north-south clusters and projects in Blue Economy. During last May in Palermo, the 2<sup>nd</sup> Hackathon WestMed Blue Economy also took place in order to prepare the Summit of the two Shores. To find more about the click <a href="here">here</a>.
  - Panoramed has launched and approved 4 Strategic projects on Maritime Surveillance and Coastal Tourism. 2020 will focus on innovation. To find more about Panoramed click <a href="here">here</a>
- V. Interreg and ENI programmes share the challenges and meets contributes to the same objectives. Financing opportunities have different timing. Many Interreg projects are giving already results and most programmes have already allocated their financial resources with their last calls. On the other, ENI still launching calls and have some resources yet to be allocated. In this framework Interact also supported the WestMed Initiative on how EU cooperation projects share the same See more.
- VI. In addition, Interact's Med lab Group participated in several events promoting the synergies among Interreg and ENI CBC programmes in the Mediterranean, as well as supporting North and South cooperation: European Week and Regions and cities (Brussels), Conference of the MSPglobal initiative, UNESCO Paris, France and Hackathons WestMED Blue Economy contribution to the Summit of the Two Shores.

In 2018, the EU Commission and the 5+5 countries (1) involved in the initiative started its implementation in coherence, complementarity and coordination with all the EU programmes and national/international funding taking place in the region.







# What happened?



- The Declaration of Alger invites the European Union to consider a future European Territorial Cooperation programmes for the period 2021-2027 to support the WestMed Initiative at sub-sea basin level.
- WestMed roadmap showed the added value and alignment between Interreg and ENI programmes and the Initiative.
- <u>Stakeholders's Conference</u> facilitated the exchange of project ideas and promote concrete project development among







Complementarities between EUSAIR and West Med. There is no doubt that complementarities between EUSAIR and WestMed Initiative exist in relevant topics, both are there to improve sustainability and growth in the Mediterranean. Each of them has a different nature, one is a macrorregional strategy, the other one a maritime initiative. Nevertheless, EUSAIR is not precisely mentioned in the WestMed Declaration but it is named in the roadmap. In the case of WestMed, it is not mentioned in the EUSAIR Catania's Declaration either. This could be redressed in the near future.

# Interreg MED governance Platform PANORAMED. Enhancing Mediterranean Governance

Panoramed is a decision making governance platform launched in September 2017 by Interreg MED

programme. 2018 was namely focused to disseminate the Platform and in particular to prepare the ToR of Panoramed Strategic calls in 2 main sectors **Coastal Tourism** and **Maritime Surveillance**. The first one, co-lead by Tuscany Region and Croatia, the second one by Secretariat de la Mer (France). The calls will be launched by mid 2019 with a budget of 12.993.252 € co-financed ERDF+IPA. 4 projects will be approved.
