9 September	European Parliament, Brussels	Joint <b>Conference</b> with MEPs (from each political group) – event content still to be agreed, flexibility. An exhibition on Interreg 30 years will also take place that week in EP
21 September	European Commission, Brussels	Celebration of <b>European Cooperation Day</b> targeted at Commission staff, exhibition in the lifts (BERL)
12-15 October	Brussels	<u>EURegions Week</u> : Global regional policy event with a large presence of Interreg in the Agora exhibition space (Cooperation Village)
15-16 October	Brussels	<b>Interreg Annual meeting</b> with ALL Interreg programmes in attendance, in cooperation with German Presidency
19-20 October	Turku, Finland	EU Strategy for the <b>Baltic Sea</b> Region Annual Forum. .
