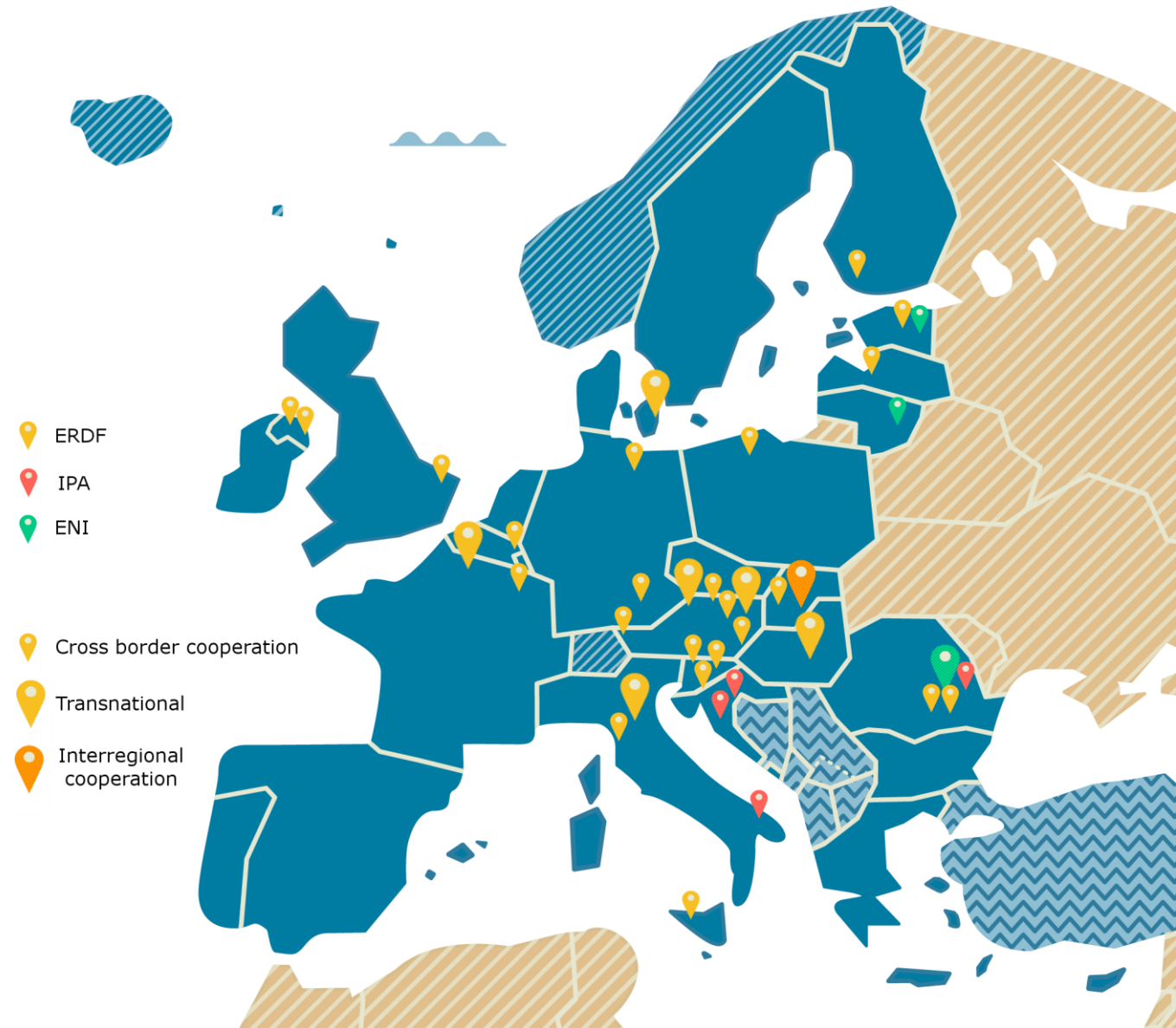


eMS – What did we achieve?

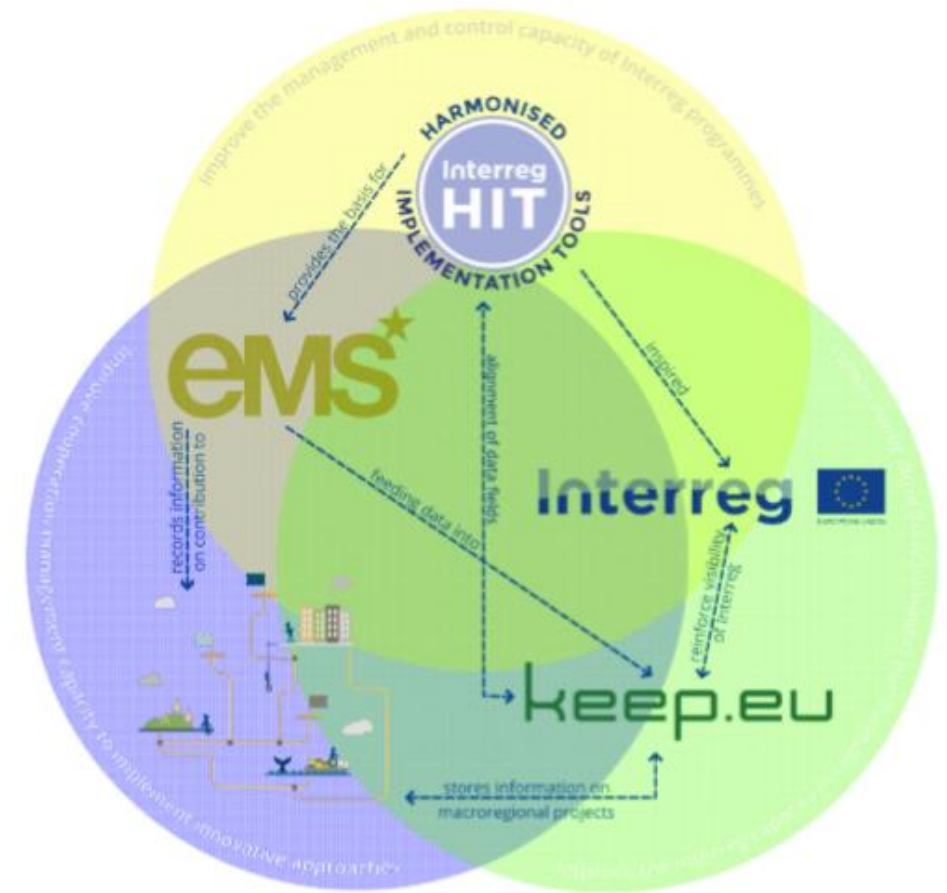
- 38 (+3) signed license agreements:

- Community – building



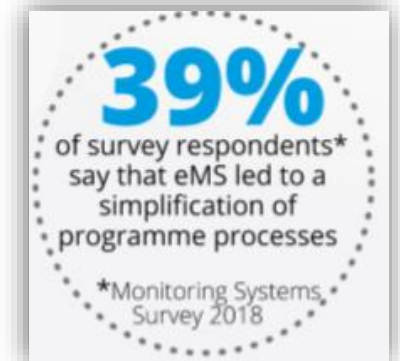
Through improved systems and tools

- Programme – specific plug-ins

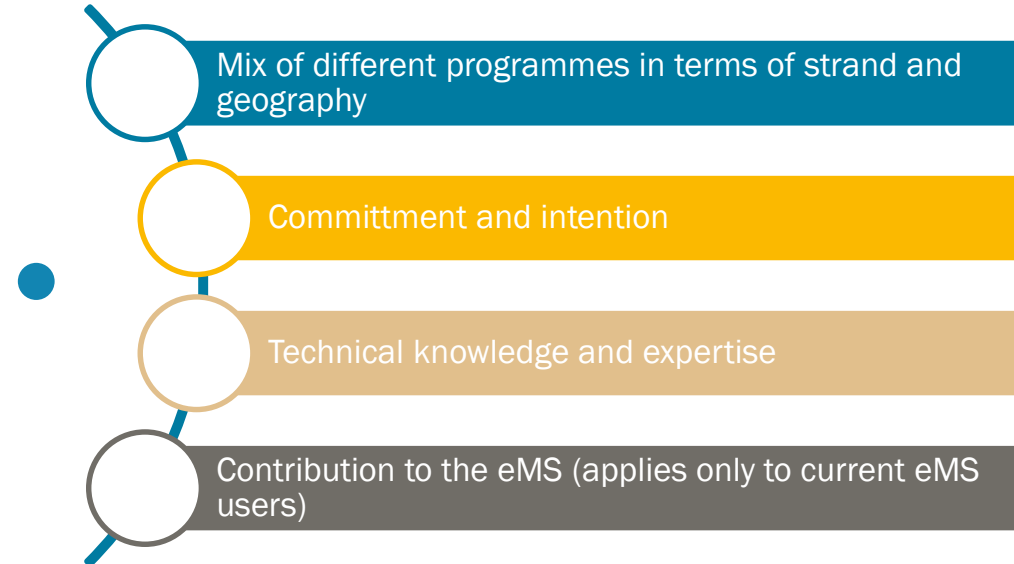
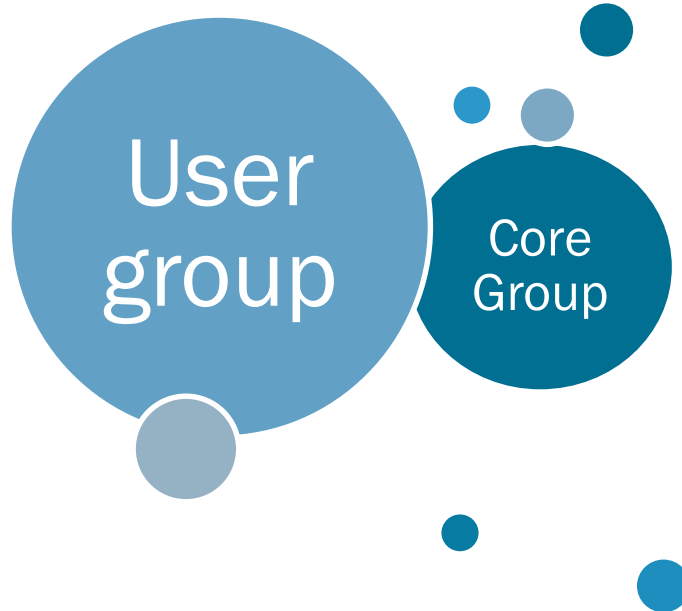


In programme authorities:

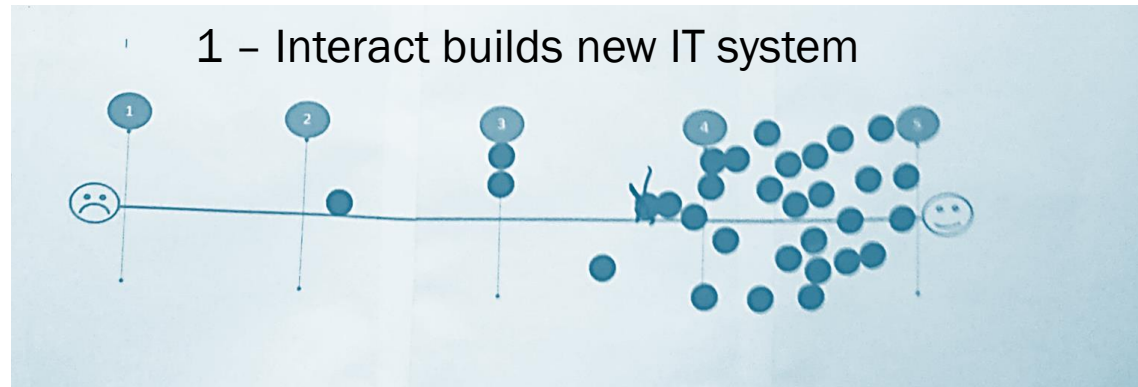
