

# **Our target**





## **Summary of the proposal for future SCOs**

#### Based on the historical data:

- A unified standard hourly rate defined for each participating country as the core of the proposal.
- Lump sum for the preparation costs and the strategy forum.

#### Off-the-shelf options:

- 15% flat rate for office and administration costs, based on staff cost
- 15% flat rate for the travel and accommodation costs, based on staff cost
- 40% flat rate for costs other than staff (small projects / EUSBSR support)

#### **Real costs:**

 only related to the external services, equipment and infrastructure and works in regular projects.



# Main principles of the methodology for hourly rate

**Population** – all unique project partners form priorities 1-3 and 4.2.

**Sample** – 20% of partners from each country minimum one reported employee per selected partner.

**Source of data** – salary reported via staff cost tools.

**Reality check** – comparison with EUROSTAT and national labour statistic.

**Indexation** – based on labour cost index per country.



### **Next steps:**

- 1. Ex-ante assessment of Audit Authority.
- 2. Management verification of SCOs.
- Final result approved by the Monitoring Committee and included in the Programme Manual.
