
In the Programme manual, a “**deliverable**” can be defined as the physical evidence of what has been produced through an activity or as the physical evidence/support of the output that was produced through an activity.

Why develop this tool?

- The monitoring system Synergie CTE could handle the expected deliverables listed in the application form, but not their quality or content.
- MED JS wanted to go further in the monitoring of produced content by providing an interactive platform for management, review and validation.

Technical solution : Web Platform

- No possibility to modify the monitoring system, so the best alternative was to use the Web Platform.
- The unique architecture of the web platform had already allowed the projects to offer a homogeneous environment for their websites. It also became a centralization point for all their productions.





Technical solution : Web Platform

- Module development was outsourced to the website provider, with Typo3 engine. It took 33 days of development for a total budget of 32 k€.
- Expected deliverables CSV export was provided by the Synergie CTE Team

Benefits

- Analysis of the quality of the deliverables (compliance, transferability, coverage, ...),
- Identification of key deliverables (flagship deliverable tag, publication on the Programme website, ...),
- Geolocation,
- Link to projects events in their websites,

Constraints

- 2 distinct management systems and the only link between is a manually generated and imported file
- High volume of deliverables to handle (about 10.000 up to now) with the Typo3 engine, which is powerful but very slow
- Summary dashboards are done manually


