

TAKING COOPERATION FORWARD

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Key features of the Interreg CE 2021-2027 methodology paper

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OVERALL CONTEXT



Performance framework required by the draft Common provisions regulation (Article 12), consisting of:

- Output and result indicators linked to programme specific objectives
- Milestones to be achieved by the end of 2024 for output indicators
- Final targets to be achieved by the end of 2029 for output and result indicators

Methodology paper = methodological approaches for the establishment of the performance framework including:

- Criteria applied to select indicators
- Data or evidence used (data quality assurance)
- Calculation methods and additional factors that may influence the achievement of the milestones and targets

RATIONALE FOR SELECTION OF INDICATORS

Indicator system: Direct correlation with programme strategy and intervention logic

Programme strategy: Interreg CE encourages and supports transnational cooperation



Interreg-specific common output and result indicators exclusively selected to reflect this cooperation focus

Main principles:

- Good coverage of key outputs and results with an overall limited number of indicators
- Clear logic between output and related result indicators
- Core set of indicators for all programme SOs, allowing aggregation at thematic levels and programme level
- Collecting reliable data at project level through reporting/monitoring (no additional administrative burden, harmonised definitions - EC indicator fiches, avoiding double counting)

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MILESTONE AND TARGET SETTING

Overall calculation method - quantification based on:

- Allocation of funds as foreseen for each programme priority
- Expected size and number of projects to be supported under each SO
- Expert advices, in particular the members of the Interreg CE programming task force (Working Group CE21+)
- Experience from Interreg CE 2014-2020 and predecessor CE 2007-2013 programmes (e.g. historical data on project size, number of outputs generated by projects, etc.)



2024 milestones for output indicators: Consideration of planned road map of programme implementation and project life cycle



METHODOLOGY PAPER SUMMARY TABLE

- Links between actions indicators targets budget allocation intervention fields to be displayed in a summary table (annex 3, Staff working document, version 4/12/2020)
- Particular challenge for TN cooperation programmes due to
 - Bottom up project development approach
 - Comparably limited financial volume of Interreg actions supported

Approach applied by Interreg CE:

- Grouping of examples of actions (as in the IP) into a few "action clusters" per SO
- Displaying the links required
- Approach has been accepted by EC
- Will now be prepared for each SO and included in the methodology paper
