# Coordination activities and synergies during the programme / project life cycle

### CE 2014-2020

- Application phase
  - Shaping of calls
  - Quality assessment
- Project implementation
  - Monitoring
  - X-fertilisation & Capitalisation

Ongoing exchange with other (Interreg) programmes, including participation in various Interact networks

## **Quality Assessment and Monitoring**

### <u>Assessment</u>

For recommended proposals cross-checks with other TN Interreg Programmes (KEEP, project websites, direct exchanges with programmes etc.)

- $\rightarrow$  to limit the risk of double funding
- $\rightarrow$  to identify thematically similar projects for synergies



Conditions for approval or recommendations for enhancing synergies between projects

In very few cases, rejection of proposal (if overlaps cannot be healed through conditions, e.g.
very similar intervention logic and activities, highly overlapping partnership)

### Monitoring

- Enhancing joint activities (e.g. events, stakeholder involvement) and linking up to other projects and (EU) initiatives
- If applicable, exchanges with other TN programmes (e.g. regarding certain deliverables/outputs, modification requests)
