The two objectives of Interact's Knowledge of the seas network are on the hand to provide an opportunity for a thematic exchange and learning from each other. And on the other hand, to jointly promote the added value of maritime cooperation, of cooperation across maritime borders supported by Interreg. For this purpose, the Knowledge of the seas organises annual thematic events which bring together the maritime Interreg (programme and project) community with thematic actors and experts as well as the policy and (regional) strategy level.

Objectives

This year's thematic event of Interact's Knowledge of the seas network will focus on Blue Energy. In the <u>EU Blue Economy Report 2021</u>, Ocean Energy has been highlighted as one of the Emerging Sectors. It is therefore interesting to discuss and exchange on what is the potential for maritime cooperation, for cooperation across maritime borders supported by Interreg in the field of marine renewable energy. Especially in view of the soon-to-kick-off new 2021-2027 Interreg programes.

The format of this year's thematic event will be different from previous years. While the event itself will be a 1,5h interactive discussion and exchange on the potential of Interreg in the field of Blue Energy, all the information, presentations etc. will be provided beforehand. This way, participants can receive and digest the information at any time and place they prefer <u>before the event</u>, and the online meeting itself can focus on the discussion among the participants.
