IR-E 2021-2027: timetable

- December 2019: first Programming Committee (PC) meeting
- February 2021: PC approved draft Cooperation Programme
- March to April 2021: public consultation
- Spring & summer 2021: final approval by Partner States
- Approval by EC expected early 2022
- First semester 2022: first call launched
