### **Outline**

The assessment and selection of projects is most probably the decisive step in the project management cycle of an Interreg programme. To fund projects with high value-added in compliance with the programme objectives is the key purpose for every Interreg programme.

In close cooperation with colleagues from DG Regio we want to focus on these two steps. The first webinar focuses on the **building blocks** and technical requirements. In the second webinar we would like to focus on the **process** and practical implications.

Seemingly, there is still work to be done in that regard. The European Court of Auditor's (ECA) Report on Interreg has revealed that selection is one of the major deficiencies in many programmes and a significant number of projects fails to achieve sustainable results; the latter point indicates another challenge which is linked to deficiencies in selection.

In this webinar we will focus on the process from different but quite practical perspectives.

- Taking the decision
