As a follow-up to the events organised in 2021 and 2022, Interact organises this event to share knowledge and views on green public procurement through dialogue among experts and practitioners from programmes and sharing a couple of successful practices. Panel members will explain how to use public procurement, its rationale and specific aspects of the processes to encourage more green and sustainable procurement. 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
