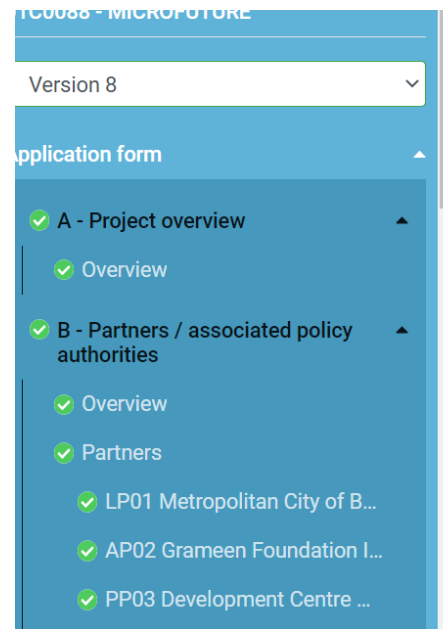
Organisations database imported to the **website** => users link their community profiles to an already existing organisation or create a new one

- Name suggestion while typing
- Name, country, NUTS, legal status blocked

Result (current situation)

Pros:

- Single list of organisations, projects partners linked to the same institution => more meaningful indicators and communication

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Result (current situation)

Cons:

- a lot of work for the SysAdmins (correcting typos, legal status and name changes etc.)
- any change to the organisation is applied to all projects and in all application form versions

Problem

How to reconcile:

- List of unique partners
- JS not being involved in partner name changes
- Partners able to change the organisation name at all times
- Mitigate the risks linked to users changing organisation data in other projects
- Partners who selected same organisation, now disagreeing on the name
- Keeping old organisation name in the old versions of the AF in case of legal succession

Solution

1. Clean the organisation list (**merge clear duplicates**) involved in recommended projects
2. Add **project dependent** fields:
 - Department
 - Department address

Solution

3. Make the **partner name editable** to project users
 - Focus on UX to prevent unwanted changes
 - Automatic notification to other project users and JS officers
4. **Link new organisation** with the old partner in case of legal succession (all budget and activities data are kept)

Solution

5. Potentially more cleaning done by COM unit (?)
6. Potentially a cleaning of organisations involved in recommended projects after each call
7. Accept that the **result will not be 100% correct**

Other actions we considered

1. Using VAT as unique identifier more consistently
 - Pre-formatting VAT fields
 - Blocking creation of new organisations with same VAT no
2. Adding other identifiers (PIC)
3. Blocking the creation of new organisations
4. Cleaning the entire organisation list

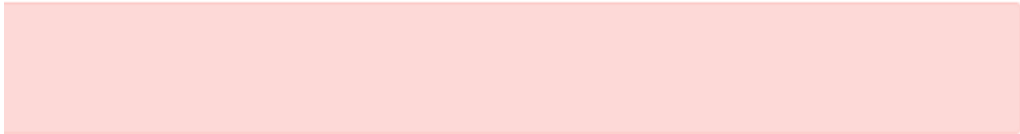
