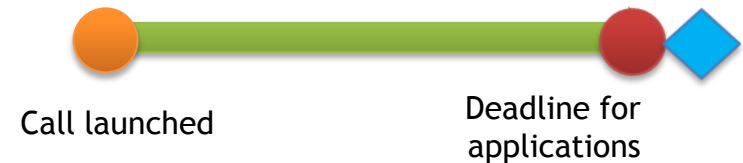


Types of calls for proposals based on duration of the submission phase

Concept note - Expression of interest (EoI)



- What do you use in your programme?
- Which information does your programme require from your projects in the concept note / EoI?



Advantages of the two-step application procedure

- less time needed as not all projects are assessed in depth;
- easier time management;
- saved capacities and costs at applicant level;
- if only limited number of proposals are invited to submit the full project proposal programme can advise project more into details
- ...
