




The Programme Intervention Logic









Project Intervention Logic





Project Intervention Logic Definitions

Overall objective: Provides overall context for what the project is trying to achieve, and aligns to programme priority specific objective. It relates to the *strategic aspects* of the project.


Specific objective: A <u>concrete statement</u> describing what the project is <u>trying to achieve</u> referring to project main outputs. It can be evaluated at the conclusion of a project to see whether it was achieved or not.

Project result: The *immediate advantage* of carrying out the project telling us about *the benefit* of using the project main outputs. It should indicate *the change* the project is aiming for.

Project main output: The product of the activities funded telling us what has actually been *produced for the money given* to the project. It contributes directly to the achievement of the project result.









Why to make a link?

Only if project objectives contribute to programme objectives... and Only if project indicators contribute to achievement of programme indicators ...will the project be financed!

How to make a link ...

Programme output indicators	Project main outputs
Number of people trained on energy efficiency	250 people from the whole programme area trained on energy efficiency in primary and secondary schools
Number of enterprises cooperating with research institutions	 3 medium-sized enterprises 12 micro-sized enterprises (3 from each participating country)
Length of newly built, reconstructed or upgraded transport infrastructure	8 km of newly built road connecting village D from YY and town U from XX





How to make a link ...

In the HIT application form:

- Select programme priority
- Select specific objective
- Select on result indicator and describe how the project can contribute the programme result (not aggregated)
- Output indicator: select one per output (will be aggregated)

Linking the project to the programme intervention logic project perspective

Advantages

INTERACT

- Present concrete outputs (aggregate outputs)
- Clarity how the project can benefit to the programme area
- Structured approach when developing their project idea

Disadvantages

- Less room for innovations
- LP might perceive certain documents more complex
- Formally exceptional projects created by project writers



Linking the project to the programme intervention logic programme perspective

Advantages

INTERACT

- More clarity how the project can benefit to the programme area through contributing to the programme objectives/results
- It should be easier to monitor for programme staff
- It should be easier to evaluate

Disadvantages

- Less room for innovations
- lower number of proposals received because the programme specific objectives are perceived as too narrow
