





- Covers all EU (and EFTA/EEA) land-borders





Figure 5: Relevance and frequency of obstacles



1st place: Legal and administrative barriers, esp. labour market

2nd place: language

3rd place: access







Main conclusions so far

- 1. All three pillars converge in their findings:
 - a) Certain policy areas more relevant than others in a cross-border obstacles context (labour mobility!)
 - b) Language and information = seen as key
 - c) Prevalence of border obstacles varies dramatically
- 2. A multi-level approach is necessary, european MS and regional responsibilities
- 3. Interreg has a role to play: important for the future





Next steps - 2017

- Communication of the Commission to Council and EP (June 2017 adoption)
- 2. Launch event + 3 smaller border events
- 3. Other actions: pilot solutions, TIA, database, etc




