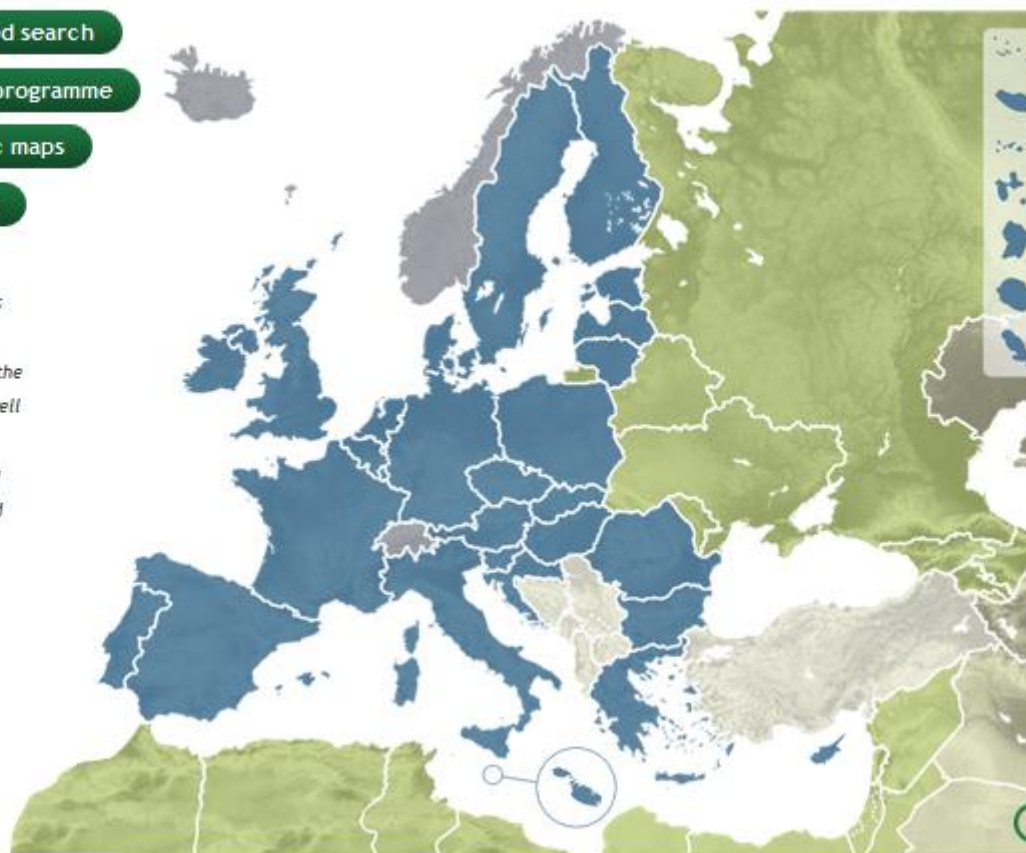

TERVETULOA KEEPIIN

KEEP on kattavin tarjolla oleva tietolähde Interreg-, Interreg-IPA- ja ENPI/ENI-yhteistyöohjelmista sekä niiden hankkeista ja hankepartnereista.

KEEP tarjoaa myös maakohtaista tietoa Euroopan unionin jäsenvaltioista sekä Euroopan unionin hakija- ja naapurimaista. Tämä on käyttämälle kielellä mukainen johdantosisu. Voitte käyttää alhaalla olevia linkkejä siirtyäkseen haluamiinne englanninkielisiin osiin KEEPISSÄ.

Mitä hyötyä KEEPIstä on?

KEEPin avulla voitte:

- Tarkastella yhteistyöohjelmien tärkeimpiä tilastoja (esim. partnereiden ja hankkeiden lukumääristä tai temaattisesta ja maantieteellisestä jakautumisesta)
- Etsiä tietoa alueellisesti tai kansallisesti kiinnostavista hankkeista ja investoinneista sekä niiden tuloksista
- Rakentaa temaattista kokonaiskuvaa siitä, miten yhteistyöohjelmien avulla on käsitelty erilaisia tärkeitä teemoja kuten ilmastonmuutos tai maahanmuutto
- Ideoida uusia hankkeita jo tehtyjen hankkeiden pohjalta
- Hakea hankepartnereita läheltä tai kaukaa

Miksi KEEP on ilmainen?

KEEPin käyttö on ilmaista. EU:n rahoittama Interact-ohjelmaylläpitää ja kehittää KEEPIä keskeisenä osanotehtävänsä. KEEPISSÄ olevaa tietoa hallinnoidaan niiden satojen ohjelmien alaisuudessa, jotka muodostavat alueellisen yhteistyön kokonaisuuden vuodesta 2000 alkaen.

KEEPin verkkosivusto on englanninkielinen. KEEPin tietokanta sen sijaan sisältää tietoa Euroopan eri kielillä sen mukaan, mikä tai mitkä kielet ovat käytössä kussakin ohjelmassa. Toivomme, että löydätte KEEPIstä teille mielenkiintoista ja hyödyllistä tietoa. Jos teillä on kysymyksiä tai ehdotuksia tai haluatte tietää lisää KEEPIstä, ottakaa yhteyttä.

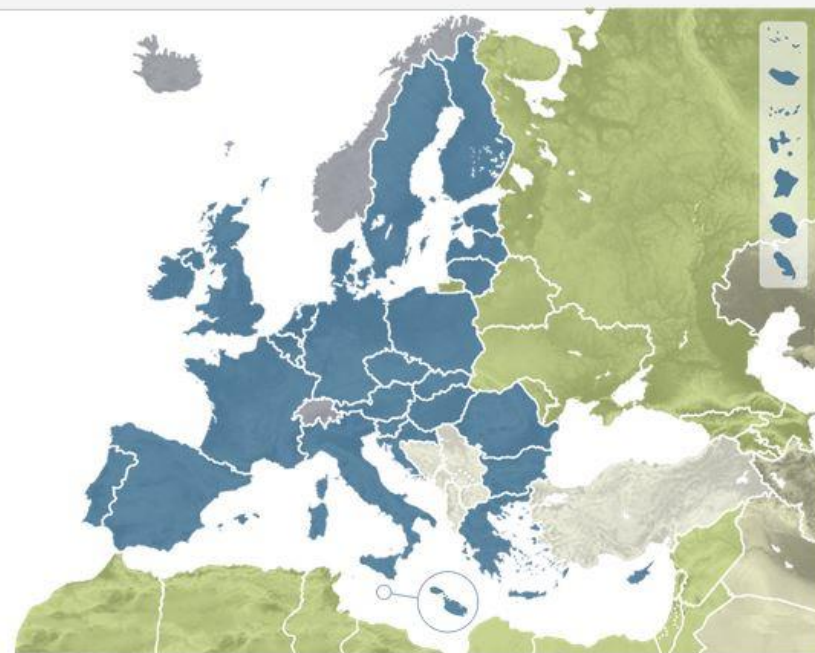
