Interreg Volunteers Initiative resources and scope

- For 2017, EUR 1 million of ERDF TA resources (legal basis art.58 CPR)
- Cross-border, Transnational, Interregional programmes
- Young people aged between 18 and 30



Interreg Volunteers Initiative What we will cover


- A daily allowance, varying depending on country, covering food, accomodation, meal
- First and last trip to and from the deployment place
- Insurance

- Interreg Reporter supporting Interreg programmes in promoting concrete results
- Interreg Project Partner volunteering on a concrete project

Interreg Project Partner: some examples

- Cross-Border health projects
- Projects dealing with vulnerable groups (e.g. projects concerning refugees, migrants and asylum seeker)
- Projects on climate change/risk prevention issues
- P2P projects
- Projects on youth drain from rural and peripheral areas (ex. "RIBS" in Central baltic programme)
