# Why do we need open data

- **Changing political context**
  - Strong need on justifying expenditure
  - Cohesion policy debate
  - Strong need to engage the citizens
- **Changing technological context**
  - Big data (more data and more capacity)
  - Demand for instant access and availability

# Why do we need open data

- Overall this generates
  - Demand for proof of performance of the policy
  - Demand for easily readable and understandable information even more than before in order to steer public debate!

- **Policy makers**

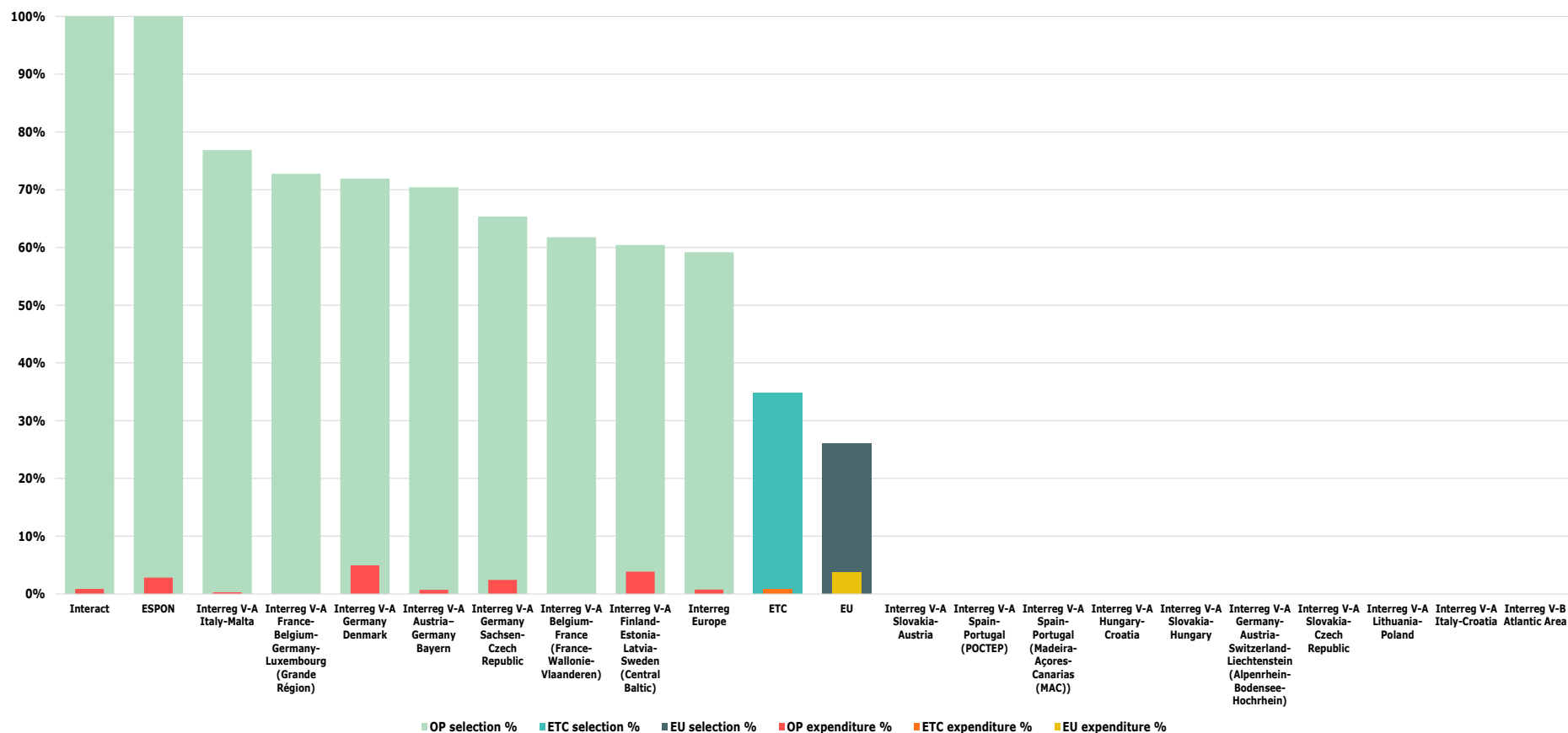
## Where the data comes from

- **Managing Authorities update financial information to SFC 3 times a year + AIR**
- **Open data platform uses data from SFC**
- **Data quality issues are more visible it is very important to ensure that data is correct when uploaded to SFC**

## Rate of selection and expenditure at 31 12 2016

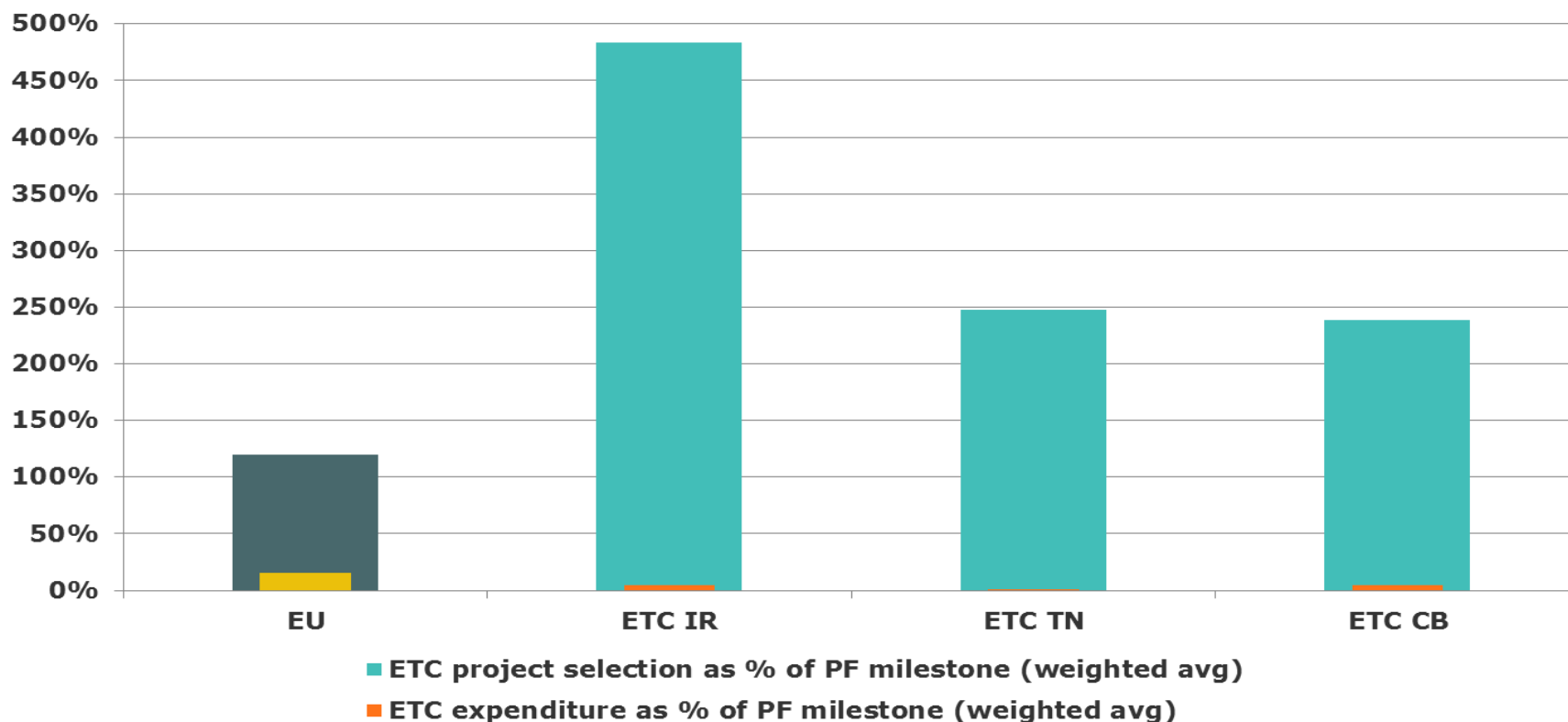


\* Calculation based on total (EU plus national) eligible cost and total expenditure declared.

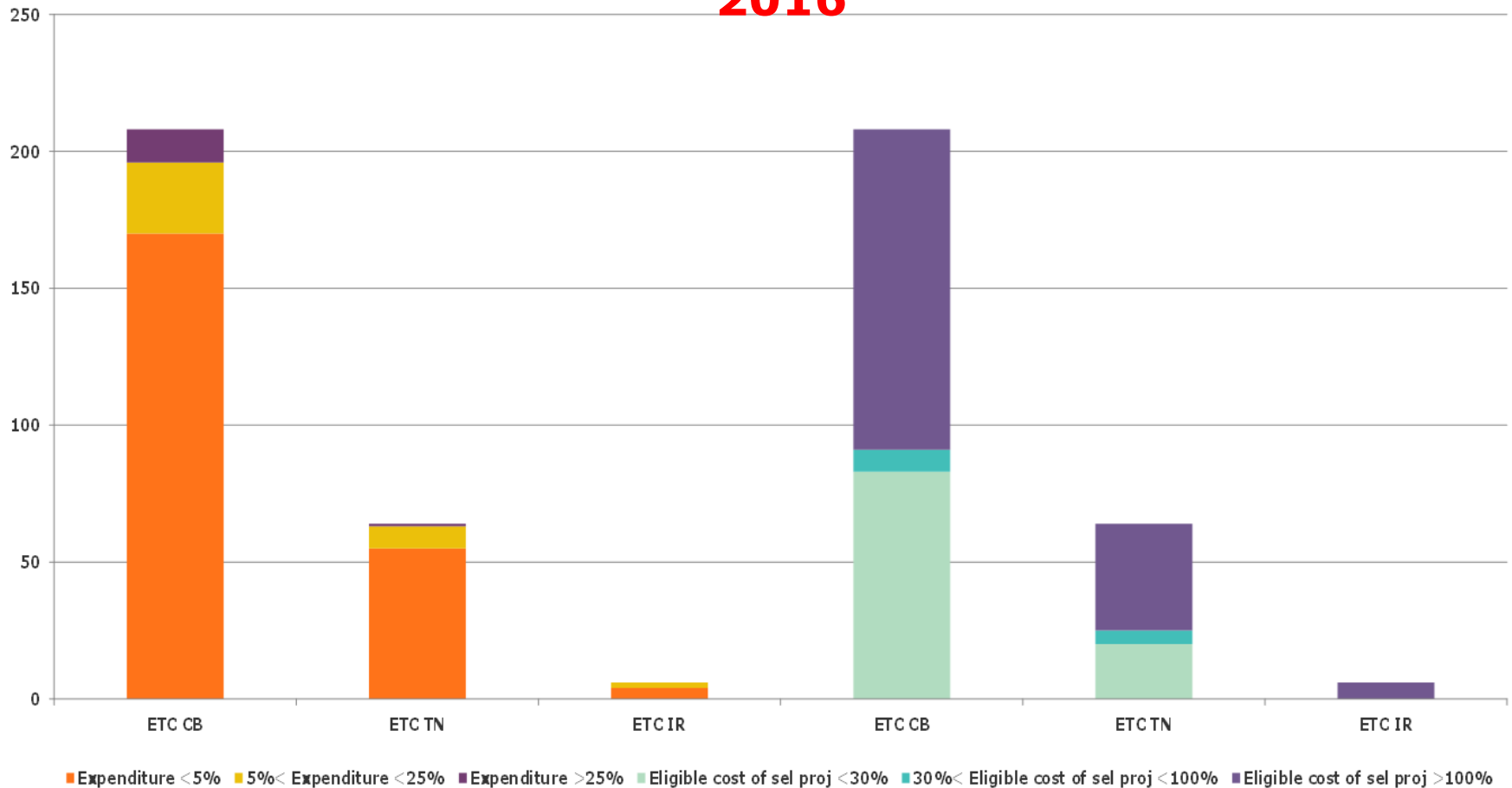
\*\* Only ten highest and ten lowest values are shown.



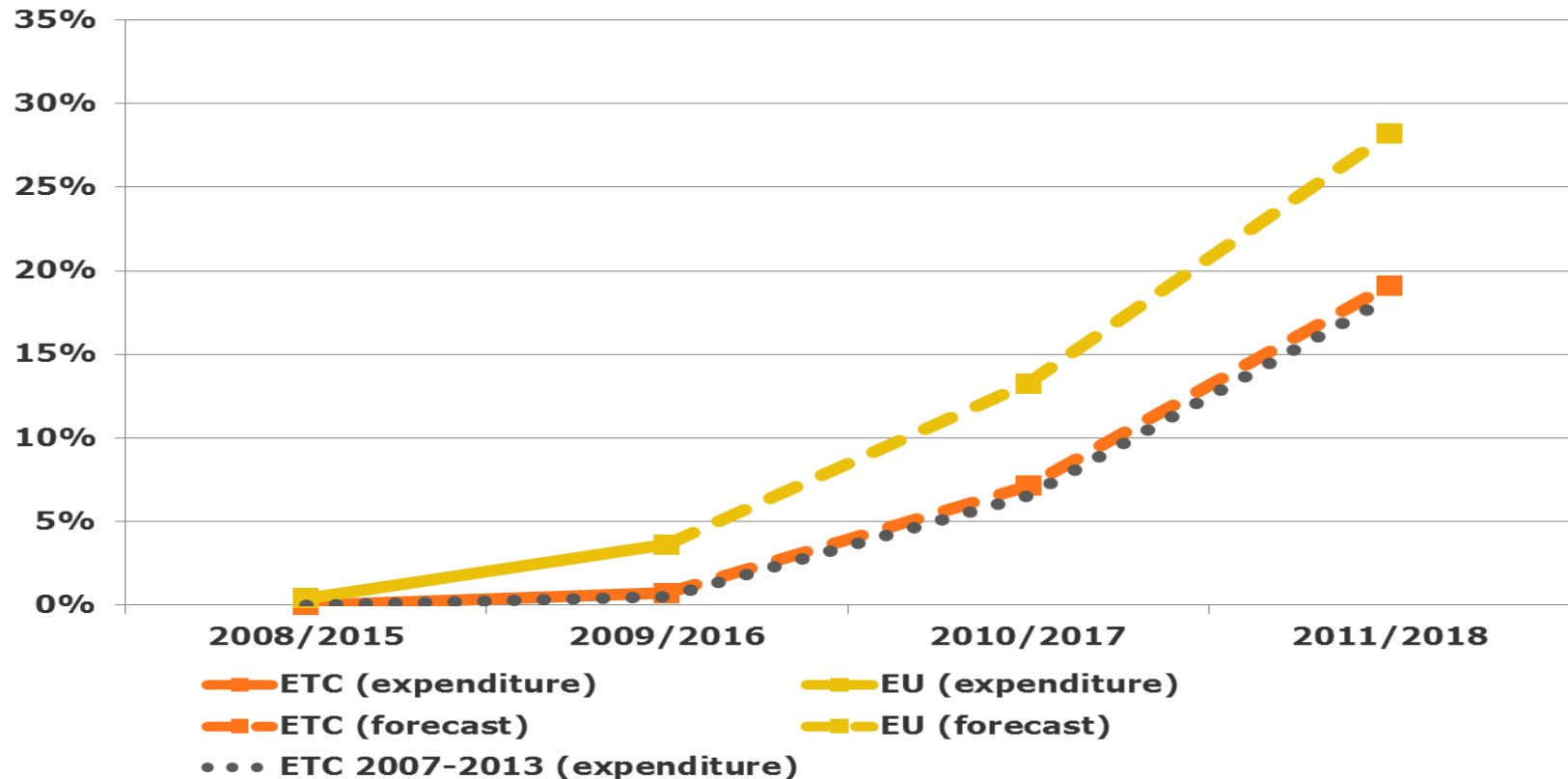
## Rate of project selection and expenditure as share of Performance Framework milestones at 31 12 2016
